Staged as a late night talk show, Hangin' with the Giants features animated likenesses of jazz greats Louis Armstrong, Duke Ellington, Charlie Parker, Dizzy Gillespie, Miles Davis and Thelonious Monk as show guests. This program targets grades K-4 and gives students the opportunity to interact with the animated characters as well as hear examples of their musical contributions to jazz.
